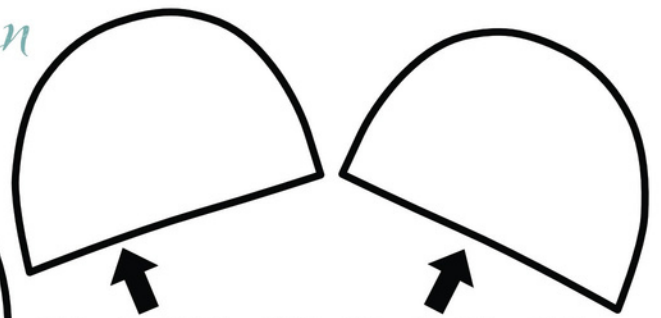
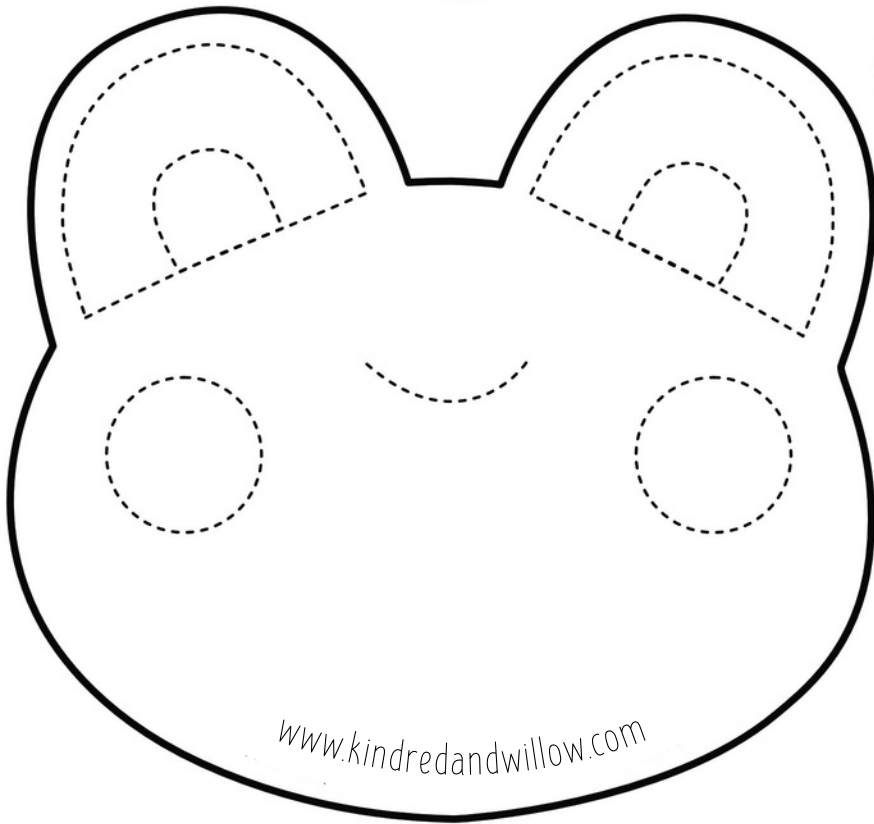
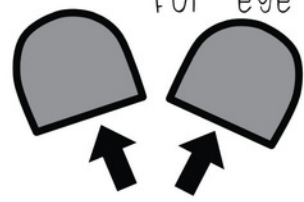


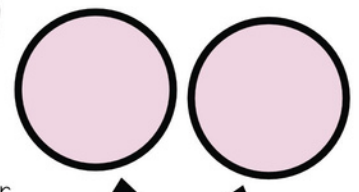
Felt Froggy Sewing Pattern



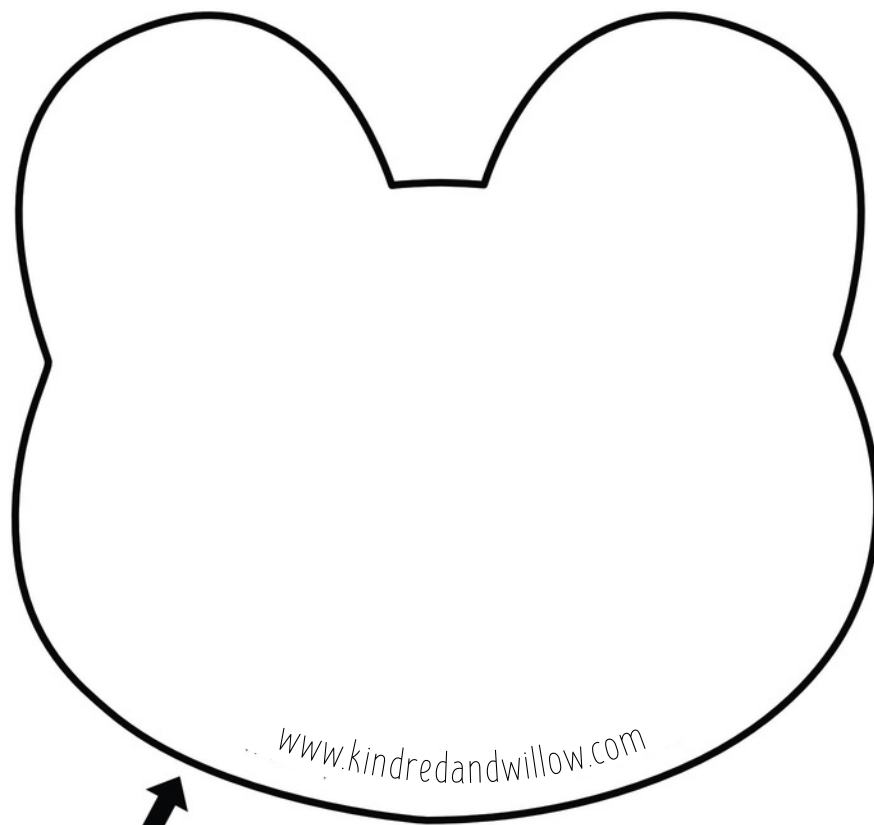
cut 1 each out of white felt for eye whites



cut 1 each out of black felt for eye pupils



cut 1 each out of pink felt for cheeks



cut 2 of green felt or whatever colour you would like your froggy to be!

MATERIALS

- Felt: green, white, pink, black
- Embroidery FLOSS: green, white, pink, black
- Embroidery needle
- Wool or poly-fil stuffing

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut out paper pattern pieces and pin to felt in colours noted beside each pattern piece. For the smaller pieces, you can trace them in chalk or erasable marking pen.
2. Cut out your felt pieces.
3. On one of your green (main) pieces, pin on white 'eye' pieces in the places indicated by the dotted line on the pattern. Sew in place using the white embroidery floss in straight stitch.
4. Pin the black 'eye pupil' pieces to the white 'eye pieces' in the position indicated by the dotted line. Sew in place using black embroidery floss.
5. Pin the pink 'check' pieces in the position indicated by the dotted line. Sew in place with pink embroidery floss.
6. Using chain stitch or straight stitch, embroider a mouth on your froggy, either on the spot shown or wherever you'd like it to be!
7. Place the front and back (main) pieces with **wrong** sides together and begin sewing around the outer edge with blanket stitch. When you are 3/4 of the way around, stuff your froggy and then complete the blanket stitching to end. Knot thread and trim ends.
